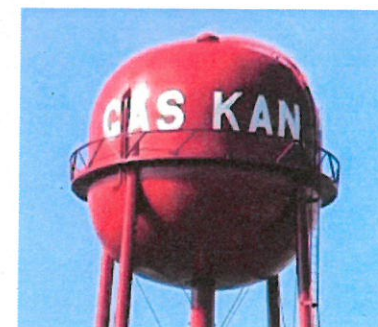

Dogs

Pit Bull, and Rottweiler breeds are not allowed inside the City limits.

Leash Law

It is unlawful for the owner of any dog to permit it to run at large within the city.

Licensing

All dogs over 6 months of age shall be licensed by May 1st. Owners shall present a proper rabies certificate showing current vaccination before license will be issued.

A kenneling license fee for four or more dogs is required.

Mowing



Grass and weeds on or about residential property which, because of its height, has a blight influence on the neighborhood are not permitted. Any such weeds and grass shall be presumed to be blighting if they exceed 10 inches in height. Properties in violation are subject to be mowed by the city at a cost of \$75.00 per hour, with the minimum of one hour.



Construction

A building permit is required for construction of new buildings, additions to existing buildings, fences and decks.

Utility Bills

Utility bills (which includes sewer, trash & water) are sent out around the 25th of each month. Payment is due on or before the 10th of the month. A 10% Late fee is added to bills paid after the 10th. Payments not made **before the 25th day** of the month are subject to disconnection of service. Total balance must be paid in full, along with a \$50.00 reconnection fee, before service will be reconnected.

Sewer

If your sewer lines back-up, please contact the city first as the problem could be in the main line, and the city will not be responsible for any charges incurred from a plumber if we have not been contacted first.

Trash

Any burning of trash must be done in an appropriate container with a lid in place, in order to contain trash. Any burning ban placed by the county shall be enforced to its fullest extent and obeyed by the city. Burning of trash, leaves and brush shall cease and all embers completely extinguished by dusk. No burning of any kind after dark.

City of Gas provides Trash Service. Trash pick-up day is Tuesday. We do offer cans for rent for a monthly fee.

- We will not pick up wet paint cans, fill them with a substance that will dry up the paint
- Loose trash will not be picked up, all trash must be bagged
- Please have cans at the curb on pick-up day
- 55 gallon barrels are not to be used as cans, they will not be dumped
- Single bags cannot weigh more than 60 pounds
- Fireplace ashes, cigarette butts, and animal waste must be in bags or it will not be picked up
