SPARKS/Cares Act Reimbursement

The City has received \$638.54 for reimbursement of employee wages and purchase of PPE, and sanitizing supplies.

BC/BS Reimbursement

Blue Cross reimbursed the City for Dental Insurance premiums paid for the month of April, as dentist offices were closed and not accepting appointments.

Official City Newspaper

Clerk Hill has suggested that the City Charter out of K.S.A. 12-1651 and designate www.cityofgas.com, the city website, as the official city newspaper. Discussion ensued, and Council would like to proceed. The Charter Ordinance will be presented at the next meeting.

Community Center

Councilman Robertson inquired as to when the seniors could resume meeting for coffee in the Senior Room at the Community Center, and informed the Council that the Wings of Warriors were still having their monthly meetings at the center. Mayor Baker told the Council he was not aware that Wings of Warriors were still having meetings there. He also informed them that the last communication with County Clerk Riebel in July concerning the Senior Citizen Centers, we were told that the County was serving Meals on Wheels at the Centers, but no other activities were allowed. Clerk Hill is to contact Wings of Warriors, and let them know that they cannot hold their meetings at the center until further notice, and contact Clerk Riebel for an update on what the county is doing at the senior citizen centers. Councilman Robertson would like to see in writing what the County is doing if it is available.


